

# **WELCOME WFTF World Championships Italy 2022**

**1/3**

The 2022 World Championships will be held according to WFTF rules and in compliance with the restrictive Italian firearms legislation.

There will be a triple course for a total of 75 lanes with 2 targets each. There will be many uphill/downhill shots and other challenges.

Free water, compressed air and several toilets will be available during the competition.

The rifles will be checked daily for their energy limit and marked with 3 different "O.K." labels (naturally, in Italy - Green, White and Red colour).

We strongly recommend that the first check is carried out on Tuesday the 2nd of August 2022. In this context, it is advisable to carefully study the WFTF rules.

Additional single rifle checks can be carried out on all three competition days.

All shooters must check in at the registration desk to obtain their individual FT World 2022 ID cards (essential for access and participation) as well as the welcome bag.

## PARTICIPATION COSTS

Single shooter entry fee (205 Euros, Ceremony Dinner included);

Team entry fee 140 Euro (80 PCP and 60 Springer);

Welcome dinner or refreshment (40 Euro);

Ceremony Dinner for accompanying people and guests (55 Euro);

Polystyrene for bag (free of charge)

Possible cost of rifle import permit 20 Euro (if necessary or required by the Italian Federation);

Commemorative shirts (30 Euro)

Hat (15 Euros);

Water bottle (20 Euro);

Pin (5 Euros);

Patch (10 Euros);

Marshall WFTF course (date and price to be decided).

T-shirts and various gadgets booked and paid for will be placed in the welcome bag.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Your RGB / NGB representatives will have access to a WhatsApp group, that will be created by the Organisation from the 10th of January 2022. Through this group, they can contact us for any questions or request of additional information. RGB/NGBs are asked to provide a WhatsApp-enabled phone number. During the event the WhatsApp group will also be used for urgent and important communications for shooters. Other regular communications will also be available through Facebook page and the event website.

Attention: Only your RGB / NGB representative is allowed to register. You will not be able to do this yourself.

Please do not visit Villa Cavalletti (place of competition) before the accreditation days, unless you are registered for Marshall seminars.

If you wish to practice before Tuesday 2.8.2022, please contact SS. Lazio Airguns FIDASC (via the website and with a prepayment of a small contribution as insurance coverage). In this way you can have at your disposition a full FT course with 50 Targets.

Registration fees are non-refundable. If there are vacancies remaining we will inform the WFTF community and other shooters can register against a short extended payment deadline.

Shooters who do not have a European Firearms Passport (EFP) need a rifle import license, which will be provided after they have read, completed and submitted the appropriate form that will be available online on the website, from the 1st of february 2022.

Keep the serial numbers of your rifle easily visible because they could be inspected by the Italian Customs.

It is highly recommended to carry an ID Card with a photo and the invitation to the competition, as well as the rifle import license when you are with your air rifle outside the competition.

You should contact the airline, train or ferry company you are travelling with to make sure they know you are travelling with an air rifle, so they can advise you about the procedure you need to follow to transport rifle and pellets.

**ADDITIONAL RULES:**

In Italy Airguns are covered by the Italian firearms law, which means that they can carry the same penalties as a firearm.

Airguns are not allowed on public transport (bus, coach, tram or train) also stored in a case or cover or otherwise.

Airguns must not be left in such a way that those who do not have the right can access them.

Airguns are not permitted in a public place, in a case or cover or otherwise, without reasonable cause.

A reasonable cause is travelling to and from the shooting competition site such as the WFTC 2022 or a FIDASC recognised shooting club such as the SS. Lazio Airguns.

Optics and muzzle brakes (not silencers) are all permitted on airguns.

There is no need for a muzzle flag, breech flag or any other visual device, and a lock on the trigger group is recommended.
